⁴⁾ According to Swedish regulations, an authorised signatory is the person/persons with the authority to make signatures on behalf of the company. It is usually the CEO or someone in the Board of Directors of the company or someone who has been delegated this authority. In case the signatory is not the CEO, the Swedish Customs need a signed power of attorney which confirms the delegated authority of the authorised signatory.
